DESCRIPTION:

Correspondence, documents, and printed material relating to Dorothy Rosenman's activities as a housing analyst. Mrs. Rosenman, (1900- ), served on Mayor Fiorello LaGuardia's Committee on Housing Legislation, was chairman and organizer of the National Committee on Housing Inc., was chairman of the committee working for legislation to create a New York State Division of Housing, and was chairman of the Housing Committee of the United Neighborhood Houses of New York working for better housing conditions on the lower East Side.

Mrs. Rosenman is the author of numerous articles on housing. Printed copies of these are in the collection. Among the correspondents are Fiorello LaGuardia, Eleanor Roosevelt, Bernard Baruch, and Herbert Lehman.
